- The DPL book club continues to meet monthly. There were 15 attendees for the June meeting.
- The Library Charter is being corrected as it stated that the library board would consist of 5-25 members when it should read that the library board would consist of 5-15 members.
- The library received a grant from CCLS for \$200 to help purchase marketing supplies for the Dunkirk-Fredonia Meals on Wheels joint program.
- The library also received a \$1,000 grant to help purchase additional large print and audio materials for the Dunkirk-Fredonia Meals on Wheels joint program.
- Janice attended the DHPSNY Disaster Recovery workshop in Lilydale.
- Janice is partnering with Ahira Hall Memorial Library to apply to a part of NYLA program to work on the issue of adult literacy in the north county.
- Eat Smart New York will again be holding a series of nutritional workshops during the summer.
- Janice is working on several craft workshops to be open to teens and adults during the summer.

Pam Czarniak presented the Children's Room Report: Key points include:

- The Father's Day craft day on June 10 was attended by approximately 14 patrons. Left over supplies were utilized by the kids on June 13 to make Father's Day gifts.
- Pam will be working with the Dunkirk School District's 21st Century Grant Summer Program on Monday mornings for a portion of the summer conducting story hours and craft projects.
- School Four and the Seneca Nation pre-school will be attending art classes and story time during the summer.

Under Old Business:

- The Dropbox has been delivered. Hopefully it will be installed in July depending on contractor's schedule.
- 2017-2018 Vote -- 169 total votes were cast with 72 being for the proposed budget, 91 against and 6 left blank.
